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
Configuration

LTI must be configured on both the LMS and Bodyswaps in order to connect.


Step 1: Add Bodyswaps as a tool

- Log in as an Admin to Blackboard.
- On the Administrator Panel, select LTI Tool Providers.
- Select Register LTI 1.3 /AdvantageTool.
- In the Client ID field, enter the Application ID which is: 1f6603a8-1e49-42e8-b0b2-80ee73c2e79a
- Select Submit to register the tool.
- You then need to copy the client ID and use it when creating the integration on Bodyswaps Go (shown in next steps).



Step 2: Register your LMS to Bodyswaps Go

- Navigate to Bodyswaps Go.
 - You must be an Admin and then you should then see an Integrations Tab on the left hand panel.
- Click CREATE to open the new integration window



Step 2: Register your LMS to Bodyswaps Go

• Fill in the following details:

- Switch on the 'sync grades' toggle to track grades in Blackboard.
- Click SUBMIT

Step 2: Register your LMS to Bodyswaps Go



Adding Bodyswaps into a course


Make sure Bodyswaps is added as a Tool before proceeding.

- Navigate to the Course on Blackboard
- Click Build Content and find Bodyswaps




Fill in the form

- Give it a name
- Under the Marking section, ensure Enable Evaluation is 'Yes' and Points Possible is '100' (highlighted in red below)
- All other settings can be left or changed at your discretion, then click Submit




 Navigate back to Course Homepage. You should now see Bodyswaps available.



 On Bodyswaps Go Integrations tab, click 'View' next to your integration you have just set up.

My Blackboard Integration

- Click 'Add Course' under 'Manage Course Content'
- Add in the name of the Course you have created on Blackboard and select the modules you would like to include in that course from the drop down menu.
- You can have multiple courses set up here using the one integration.




How a Student Accesses the Assigned Bodyswaps Module(s)

- Once a student logs in, they will see the Bodyswaps activity inside their course
- Inside the activity, students will need to generate an ACCESS CODE to enter into the app by following the 3 steps.
 - Select your device
 - Run the Bodyswaps App
 - Enter your access code
- If you have browser streaming enabled on your Bodyswaps account, the student will be able to skip the code generation step above and play the module within their browser.




 If multiple modules have been set, a list of modules will appear and students can select which one they'd like to do and those they have already completed.



Testing the integration (optional)

- If you would like to test the integration and get the grade to sync from an Admin account:
 - Enter Student Preview Mode by clicking the Eye Icon in the top right hand corner (screenshot below)
 - Once Student Preview Mode is on, click on the Bodyswaps content and complete the module






Testing the integration (optional)

• Once you have completed the module, you should see a completion certificate. At this point, the grade will sync.




 Navigate to 'Marks' within Blackboard, and view the grade. This is what a student will see when they complete the module in the LMS.



Testing the integration (optional)

 If you (the Admin) want to see the test data from your account, ensure you click on Keep the Preview User and all data when you go back to Admin view.



 If you navigate to the Marks section, you'll see the results of the preview student, as below. The student will be marked as 100% once a module is completed (or all modules have been completed if multiple assigned within the course).



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Best Practices

Here's a couple strategies to incorporate into your new integration!

Best Practice 1: Add an introduction to Bodyswaps for your course.

After students complete modules, add in questions to check their understanding and tie the content of the module back to the learning and takeaways from your course.
